

2011 Camper Packing List

1. Bible
2. Flashlight and Batteries
3. Bug spray
4. Lots of casual clothes, plus a little more dressy outfit if you want for our worship service (remember this is camp and it could get a little dirty). Smart to bring more than one pair of shoes in case one pair gets wet.
5. Swimsuit
6. Towels
7. Bedding – (Camp provides cots and mattresses, but you must bring your own sleeping bag, sheets and/or blankets, and pillow.
8. Spending money for extra snacks and soda. (most items are 50 cents)
9. Toiletries – soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
10. Tupperware or sealable containers for snacks in cabins. Ice chests are not allowed due to limited cabin space.

Note: We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken property so we suggest that campers do not bring any valuables with them.

Things NOT to bring:

Weapons, fireworks, cell phones, videogame systems, anything illegal. Let common sense prevail. If you are not sure, email or call Bob BEFORE you or your kid gets there with the item.
